Cookie Policy

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you first visit a website. Cookies are widely used by websites to help remember information and give you a better experience when using the website.

Certain cookies contain some personal information. For example, if you click “remember me” when logging in, a cookie will store your username. Most cookies will not collect information that identifies you and will instead collect more general information to help us analyse how well our website is performing so we can improve it.

How we use cookies

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

How to remove or block cookies

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
